It is blue and yellow.

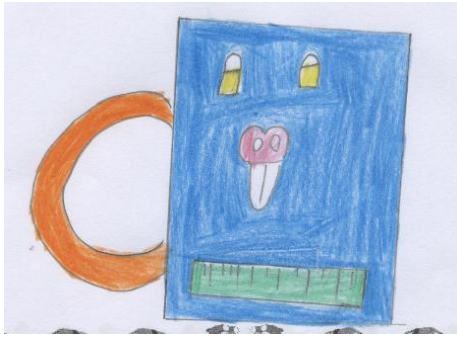
I like to swim and go hiking.
