With you, I feel safe.



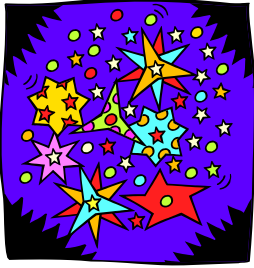
