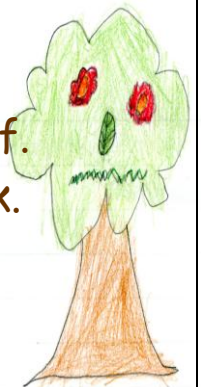
What can you see?
