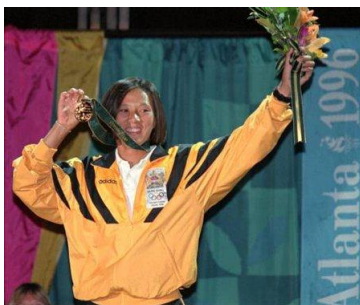
At night, Karen had a stomachache because she ate some dirty food, so her mum and dad went to a clinic with her by taxi. Her mum and dad were worried.

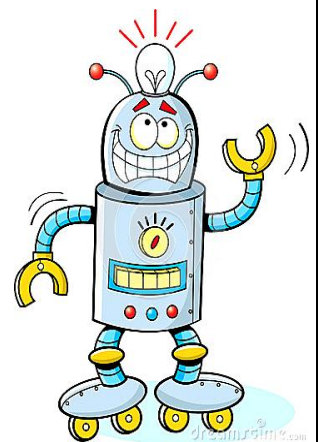
