I like her very much because she is very nice.**

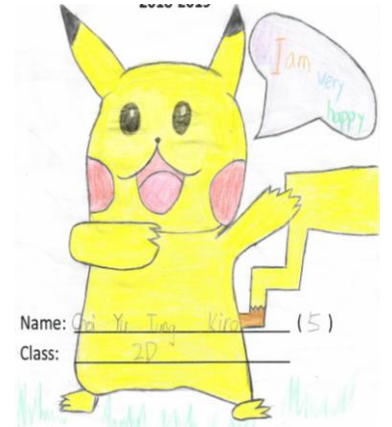


My Favourite Cartoon Character by Choi Yu Tung Kiro 2D

Pikachu is my favourite cartoon character. It has long ears, big eyes, a big mouth and a small nose. It is lovely.

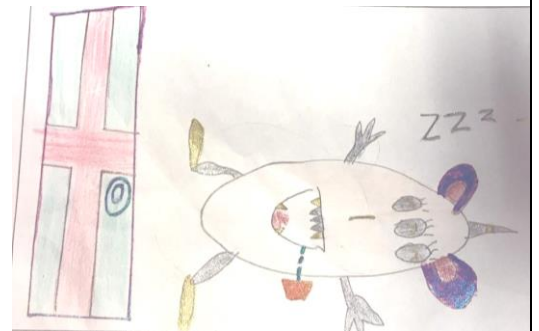
Pikachu lives in a city. It can run fast and play ball games but it can't fly. It likes to eat apples and drink apple juice. It likes to smile and jump.
